

Commodore Cash and Using Scholarship / Financial Aid to Purchase a Computer - 2023

The initial deadline to sign up for and make a **Commodore Cash** selection was July 15th. This has been extended to July 23rd.

If a Commodore Cash selection is not made by July 23, 2023, then a \$35 late fee will be assessed each time a student elects to have funds added to the Commodore Cash account via billing to their student account. There is no fee if funds are added by presenting a check or money order instead of billing to the student account.

If a student receives a scholarship or financial aid that includes an allowance to cover the cost of a laptop meeting VUSE's specifications, the student has these options:

- The student can contact student accounts to have the laptop allowance moved to their Commodore Cash account, which they can then use to purchase a laptop from the VU Bookstore.
- If all charges direct billed by Vanderbilt to the student's account have been paid, then the excess funds including the laptop allowance can be refunded to the student. The student can use the funds with any vendor to purchase a laptop computer.
- If all charges direct billed by Vanderbilt to the student's account have not been paid, then the laptop allowance funds can be applied to the outstanding charges. The student would then be responsible for using their own funds to purchase a laptop computer.
