

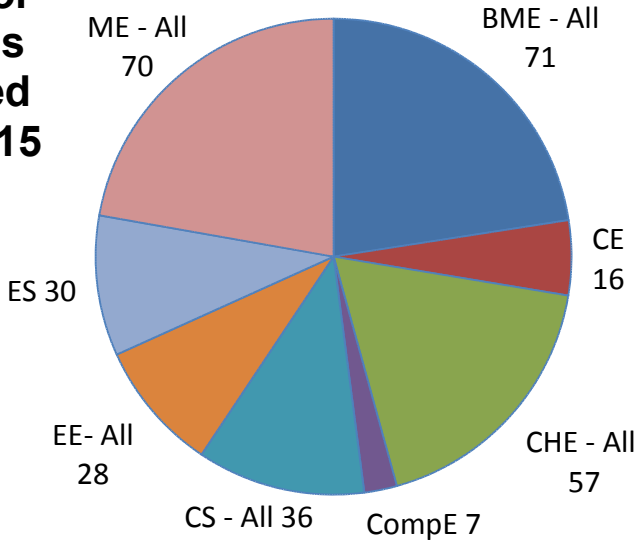


Class of 2015 Placement Highlights

as of commencement

Bachelor Degrees Awarded 2014/2015

Eight (8) students with double majors are counted in each major.



74% of the Class of 2015 planned to enter the workforce, down from 77% in 2014.

- Of domestic students (US citizens or permanent residents), 80% had at least one job offer by commencement.
- Most international students return to their home country to seek work.
- The average and median reported starting salaries were up 4% and 5%, respectively, from 2014.
- Domestic students headed to the workforce were more likely to receive a job offer if they earned an ENGM minor (89% vs. 75%).
- VUSE students are mobile; 80% accepted a job in a state other than their home state.

Placement of May 2015 Graduates

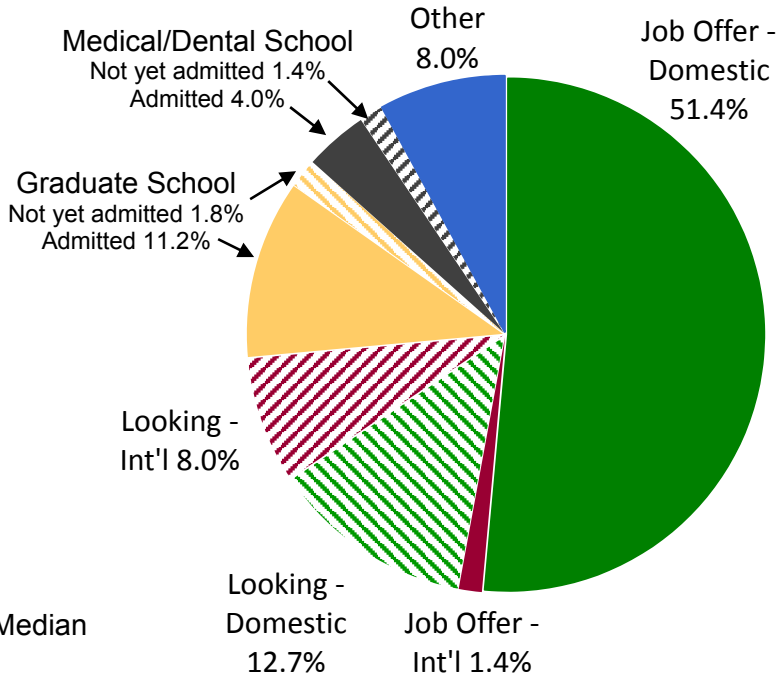
19% of the Class of 2015 planned to attend graduate or professional school.

Regarding those headed to graduate school:

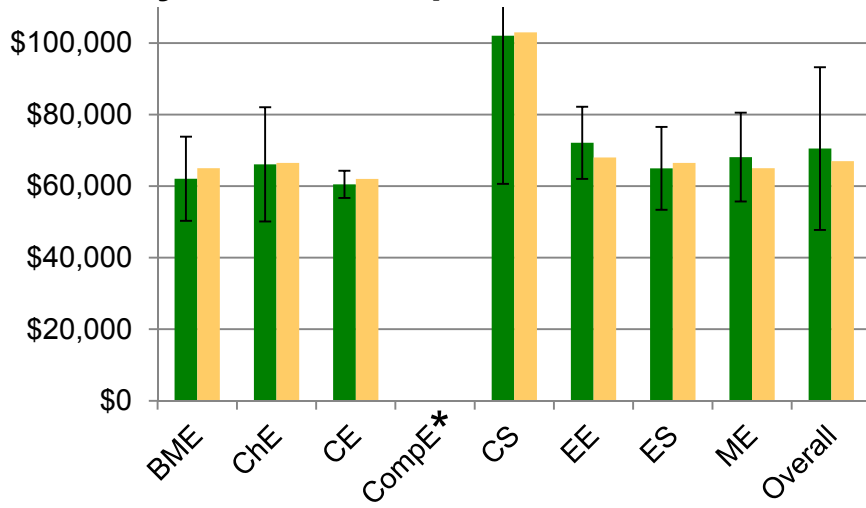
- 62% expressed clear intention to pursue a doctorate.
- 62% planned to study engineering or computer science.
- Average reported annual stipend for graduate study was \$23,975, and the median was \$28,385 (N=18).

Regarding those intending to enter medical school:

- 73% were admitted, compared to 82% in 2014.



Average and Median Salary Offers Accepted



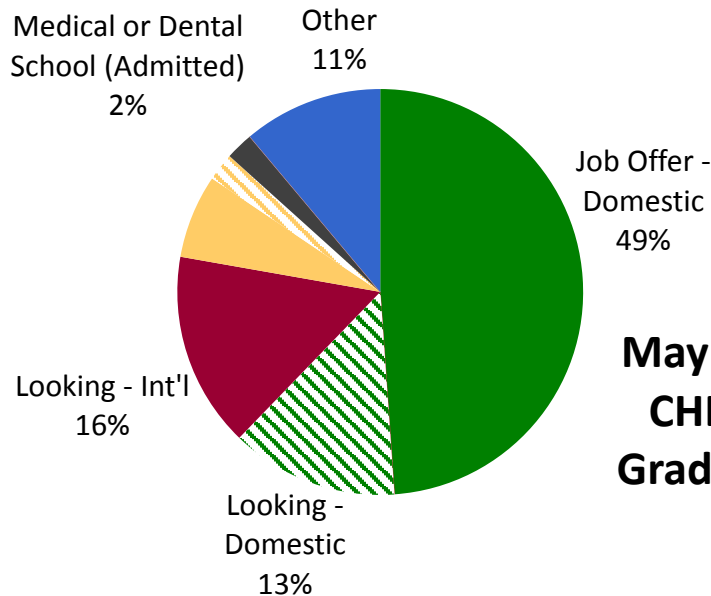
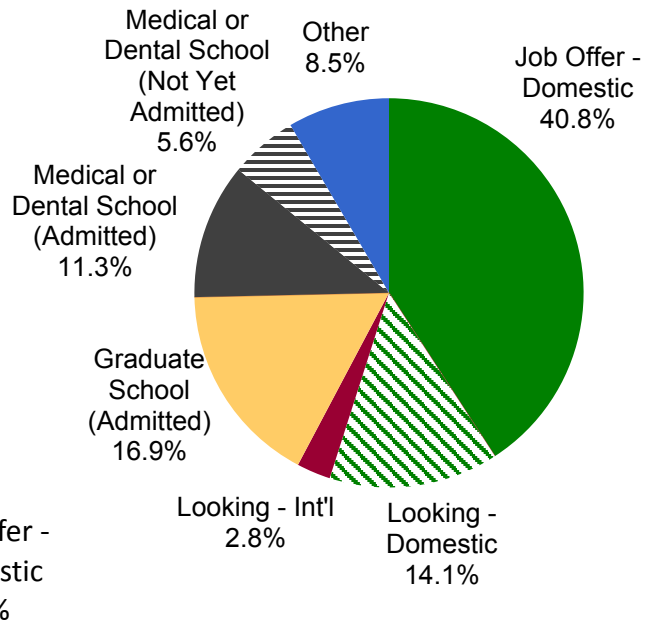
- Salaries reported (N=124) for domestic graduates accepting employment.
- Error bars indicate standard deviation of accepted salary offers.
- Salaries varied significantly by region.
- *Insufficient data obtained to report computer engineering salaries accepted.

Data were drawn from the commencement program, VU student records, YES, and most of all from the VUSE "Survey of Future Plans" given in the month prior to commencement to all May graduates. The overall response rate was 94%.

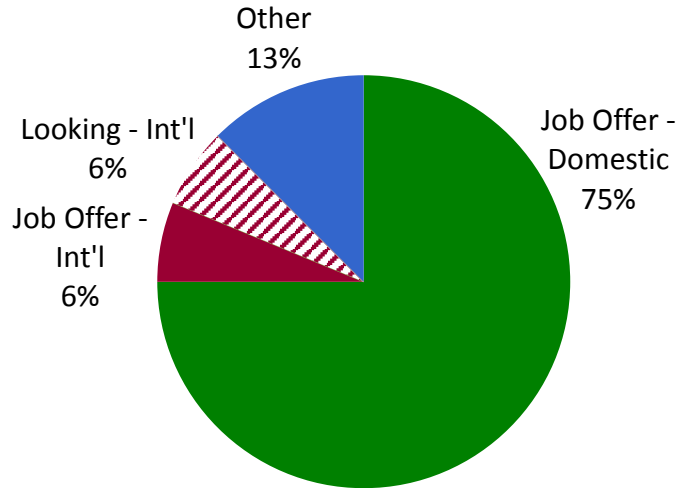

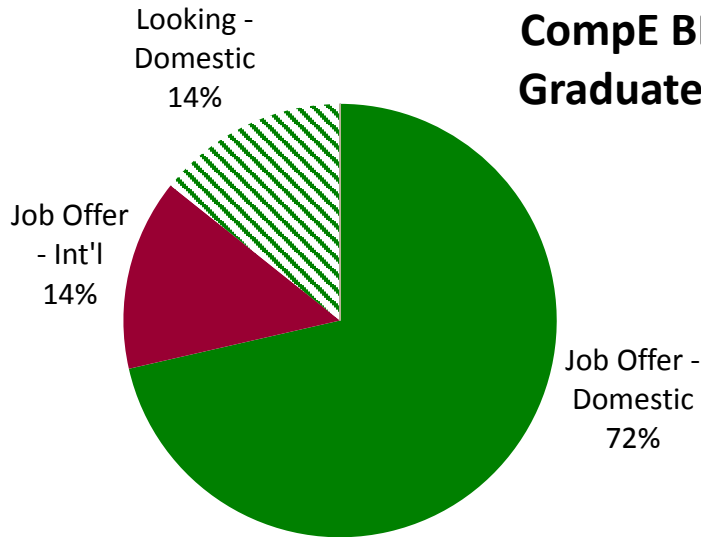

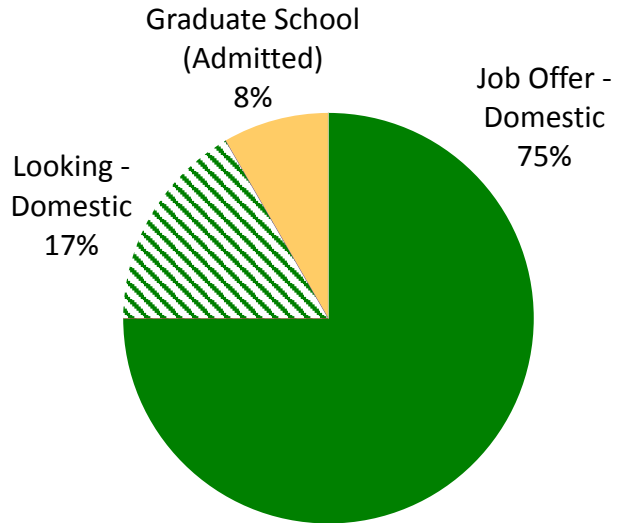

- Working for Amazon, Metova, Microsoft, and National Instruments, with additional offers from BNY Mellon and Optio Labs under consideration.

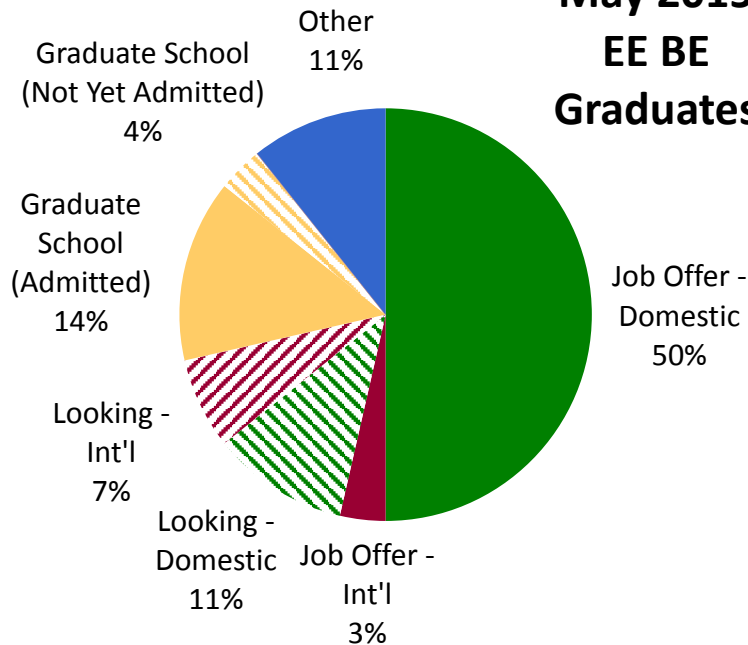
Computer Science BS Graduates from the Class of 2015 are

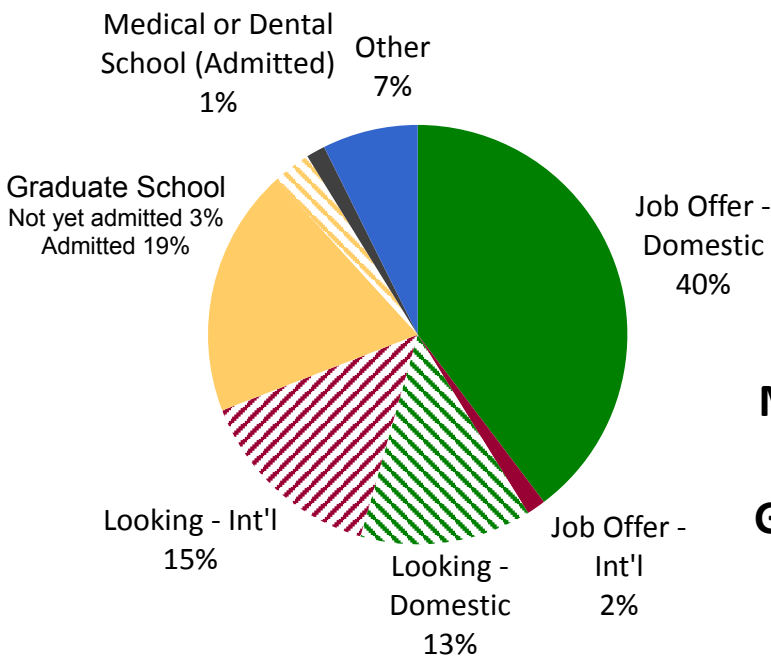
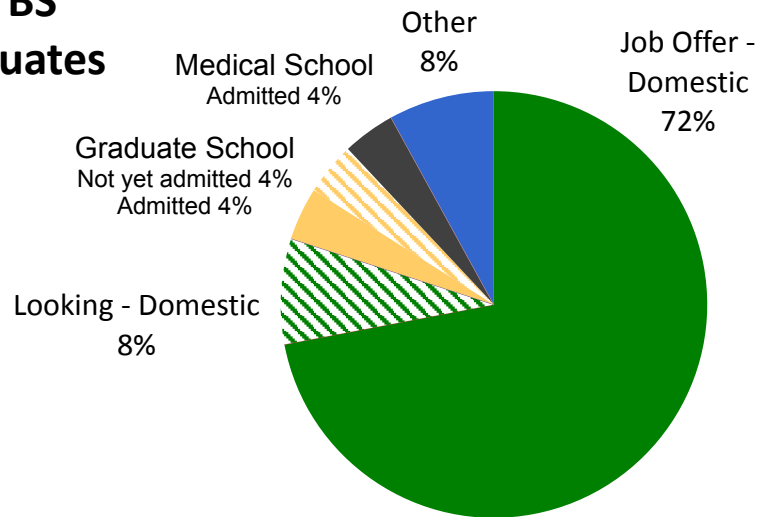
